GENERAL QUESTIONS

Are your programs available on a part-time basis?

The **M2** level of the Master's programme **MP2** can be offered on a part-time basis under some criteria. The Master's programme **P2Food** is only offered on a full-time basis.

Can I study at AgroSup Dijon on a distance-learning basis?

Sorry, this is currently not possible.

Are there admission quotas for certain countries or regions?

No. AgroSup Dijon accepts students based on a combination of academic merit, professional experience, and demonstrated interest for the intended degree programs. In administering its admissions policies, AgroSup Dijon **does not** discriminate neither on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin, religion, nor gender or sexual orientation.

Do the Master's programs offer a fall and a spring intake?

No. Currently, all master's programs start in the fall semester (**Next start of academic year will be in September 2022**)

What is the duration of the program of study?

MP² and P2Food are two-year master's degree programs, typically admitting students who have a bachelor's degree, usually run for 20 months, interrupted by a summer break which does not require presence on campus. Under some criteria direct entry in M2 is possible, the board of examiners are the one to decide whether an applicant is to be accepted in M2, therefore you should mention your interest in your cover letter.

Can I apply for your next fall's intake, if I'm in the final year of my undergraduate program and will earn my bachelor's degree next summer only?

You certainly can apply and be accepted without having earned your bachelor's degree; you will, however, only be able to enroll only if you have successfully graduated by the time the term begins at AgroSup Dijon.

What is the amount of the tuition fees?

As for today, €243 per academic year no matter the nationality of the student (European or non European) + €92 for Student Life Contribution Fees

How much are the application fees?

No application fees are charged by our institution.

What is the cost of life in France?

Here is an estimated budget (variable according your situation) of the life in Dijon:


How many applications can I submit?

You can submit 1 application per master's programme.

I submitted an application last year and am planning to apply again. Can you use my last year's materials or do I have to resubmit my application?

It is not possible to reinstate an application submitted in a previous year, so you will need to submit a new online application with all required materials even if you are applying to the same program. (You may of course want to consider revising or updating your statement of purpose, research proposal, or CV at your discretion.)


I am not an EU/EEA citizen and will need a visa to France. However, I do not currently have a passport. Can I apply all the same? Yes, you can. You will, however, need a valid passport to apply for a visa if you are admitted.


WHO CAN APPLY ?

Eligibility Requirements



Applicants must hold a Bachelor's Degree or equivalent (180 ECTS) in **biology, food science, chemistry, physical chemistry or engineering science.**

Those having completed a Master's Degree or equivalent (240 ECTS) related to **biology, chemistry or physical chemistry** can apply directly to the 2nd year.



Applicants must hold a Bachelor's Degree or equivalent (180 ECTS) in **food sciences, nutrition, biology, biochemistry** or must have a major in Science and have followed some courses in food science, nutrition. Some work experience in that area is also very much appreciated.

Language Requirements

The language of instruction for both master's programs offered by Agrosup Dijon is English.

Candidates must demonstrate proficiency in English by submitting standardized English language test scores. The following tests will be requested as a certification of the required English level :

CECRL: level B2 minimum

TOEFL: 87 points minimum

TOEIC: 785 points minimum

BULATS: 60 points minimum

First Certificate English of Cambridge
Bright Language Test: level 3 minimum

IELTS : Level 6 minimum

Candidates whose mother language is English are normally exempt from this requirement.

HOW TO APPLY?

Application dates and deadlines : Exact dates are to be announced (in March)

Application checklist (non exhaustive):

- Resume
- letter of motivation
- copy of latest degree translated in English or French
- transcripts of records from the start of your academic studies till today
- passport copy or ID
- proof of English proficiency (B2) if applicable
- Any relevant documents considered useful: letters of recommendation, volunteering certificates ...

What are the criterion upon which selection is made ?

Once the application file is considered as “complete”, several criteria will be taken into account for the selection :

- the quality of your academic file (grades)
- the coherence of your professional project
- a strong interest for the sector is a valuable added value to your file. This interest can be shown by an experience in this field (internship, project, and experiences) explained in the cover letter. This will be all the more important if you are planning to resume your studies or a change in your career path.

FINANCIAL AID

A limited number of excellence scholarships are awarded each year to high level international students. No specific application is requested, students need to mention their interest in the motivation letter though.

AFTER YOU APPLY

How long will take the process before I receive a decision on my application ?

A complete application will take no more than 60 days to be processed. When a decision has been made you will be emailed to log in to your e-candidate account and the decision will be revealed to you.

My application was successful, what do I have to do ?

On your account, you will be able to download your official admission letter which will enable you to start the visa application procedure and to enroll in our university.

My application was unsuccessful, can I find out why ?

On your account, you will be able to access a summary of the reason your application was unsuccessful.

Can I defer my place ?

No, it is not possible to defer your place, but you will be free to reapply for the next campaign. Be aware that we only have about 16 places available each year and the P2 food Master's programme has become very competitive.
